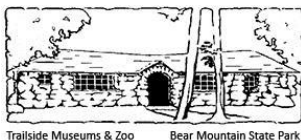


Trailside Museums and Zoo Group Visit Checklist

- Group Visit Request Form:** Please complete form (below) and submit per instructions
 - Environmental Educator Chris O'Sullivan will contact you to coordinate your visit.
- Bus Permits:** After Chris confirms your visit, contact the Bus Permits Office to apply.
 - Call 845-786-2701 x244 to arrange
 - Or, you can download an application from <https://parks.ny.gov/parks/bearmountain/details.aspx> and follow instructions.
 - Free on weekdays between Labor Day and Memorial Day.
 - A \$100 per bus fee (\$60 non-profit) is charged on all Weekends & Holidays, as well as weekdays between Memorial Day and Labor Day.
- Admission:** \$1 per person donation
 - Trailside relies on donations to help feed and care for our animals.
 - Cash or check made out to 'Trailside Museums and Zoo' can be deposited in the donation box, just inside the zoo entrance.

- Rules:** Review Trailside's rules with students and adult chaperones
 - Picnicking and consuming food is prohibited at Trailside. Picnic groves are near Hessian Lake.
 - Please be kind to our animals. No shouting. No annoying.
 - Stay on the paved paths
 - Minimum adult to child ratio is 1 adult to 10 children. Children must stay with adults. Adults are responsible for ensuring children are aware and follow the rules.
